Purpose:

To outline how Grass Roots Private Nursery Group will implement the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework, ensuring that children receive high-quality education, care, and support.

Key Principles:

- Individualised Approach: We will tailor our approach to meet the unique needs and interests of each child
- **Parent Partnership:** We will work closely with parents/carers to support children's development and learning.
- **Quality and Consistency:** We will strive to provide a high-quality and consistent early years experience for all children.
- Safe and Stimulating Environment: We will create a safe, stimulating, and inclusive environment for children to learn and grow.

EYFS Framework:

- We adhere to the EYFS framework, which sets out standards for early years provision.
- The EYFS focuses on seven areas of learning and development:
 - Communication and Language
 - Physical Development
 - Personal, Social, and Emotional Development
 - Literacy
 - Mathematics
 - Understanding the World
 - o Expressive Arts and Design
- We prioritise the three Prime Areas (Communication and Language, Physical Development, and Personal, Social, and Emotional Development) for children under three years old.

Our Approach:

- **Key Person System:** Each child will be assigned a dedicated key person who will build a strong relationship with the child and their family.
- **Observation and Assessment:** We will conduct regular observations and assessments to understand each child's individual needs and progress.
- **Individualised Planning:** We will develop personalised plans to support each child's learning and development, based on their strengths and interests.
- **Play-Based Learning:** We believe in the importance of play and will provide opportunities for children to learn through play.
- **Parent Partnership:** We will work closely with parents/carers to share information, seek their input, and involve them in their child's learning.
- Professional Development: We will ensure that our staff have the necessary qualifications, training, and skills to implement the EYFS effectively.

Additional Considerations:

- **Special Educational Needs:** We will provide additional support for children with special educational needs, working in partnership with parents/carers and professionals.
- **Safeguarding and Welfare:** We adhere to the safeguarding and welfare requirements of the EYFS to ensure children's safety and well-being.
- **Equality and Inclusion:** We promote equality and inclusion, ensuring that all children have equal opportunities to learn and develop.
- Children with allergies, intolerances and weaning stages: We aim to ensure all children are given the same opportunities to play, therefore we will adapt our use of resources to ensure safer experiences for all.

Specific Areas of Focus:

Communication and Language:

- We will support children's language development through a variety of activities, such as storytelling, singing, and role-playing.
- We will encourage children to express themselves verbally and non-verbally.
- We will provide opportunities for children to listen, speak, read, write, and understand.

Physical Development:
