Grass Roots Nursery Group: E-safety Policy

Purpose:

To establish guidelines for the safe and responsible use of technology at Grass Roots Nursery Group, protecting children and promoting digital literacy.

Key Principles:

- Safe and Secure Environment: Create a safe and secure online environment for children.
- Education and Awareness: Promote understanding of online risks and benefits.

Scope

Staff Responsibilities

- Model Appropriate Behavior: Demonstrate responsible online practices.
- Educate Children: Teach children about online safety and appropriate behavior.
- Monitor Children's Use: Supervise children's online activities.
- Report Incidents: Report any e-safety concerns or incidents to the designated online safety coordinator.

Technology Use

- Device Supervision: Supervise children's use of devices and ensure they are used in designated areas.
- Age-Appropriate Resources: Provide age-appropriate apps and websites.
- Internet Filtering: Use appropriate filtering systems to block inappropriate content.
- Unsupervised Internet Access: Prohibit unsupervised internet access for children.
- Online Safety Education: Teach children about safe internet navigation and the importance of reporting concerning content.

Handling Online Safety Incidents

- Incident Reporting: Maintain a log of online safety incidents.
- Investigation: Investigate incidents and take appropriate corrective actions.
- Communication: Communicate with parents and relevant authorities if necessary.
