# **Grass Roots Nursery Group: Learning Journeys**

# **Purpose:**

To outline the procedures for creating and maintaining Learning Journeys for each child, documenting their progress and achievements in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

### **Key Principles:**

- **Individualised Learning Journeys:** Each child will have a personalized Learning Journey that records their development and progress.
- **Parent Access:** Parents will have access to their child's Learning Journey through the Famly online system.
- **Observation and Assessment:** Regular observations and assessments will be conducted to document children's achievements and progress.
- Data Security: We will ensure the security and confidentiality of all information stored in the Learning Journey system.

#### **Procedures:**

# 1. Key Person and Observations:

- Each child will have a key person responsible for compiling their Learning Journey.
- Regular observations will be conducted and recorded in the system.

# 2. Famly System:

- We use the Famly online system to create and manage Learning Journeys.
- Staff and parents can access the system using unique login credentials.
- Staff can input new observations and photos, while parents can view and comment on existing entries.

#### 3. Moderation:

 Observations entered by staff will be moderated by a senior member of staff before being added to the Learning Journey.

# 4. Parent Access:

- Parents can only view their own child's Learning Journey.
- Parents must sign a consent form to allow their child's image to be included in other children's Learning Journeys.

### 5. Data Security:

- The Famly system is hosted on secure servers based in the UK.
- Access to information is restricted to authorized users with unique login credentials.

#### **Additional Considerations:**

- **Communication:** We will communicate with parents about their child's progress through the Learning Journey system and other channels.
- **Review:** This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure its effectiveness and alignment with current best practices.
