Grass Roots Nursery Group: Visits and Outings Policy

Purpose:

To establish guidelines for visits and outings at Grass Roots Nursery Group, ensuring a safe, enjoyable, and educational experience for children that aligns with the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework.

- **Understanding the World:** Foster curiosity, observation, and understanding of the natural world through visits to museums, parks, or other locations.
- **Expressive Arts and Design:** Encourage creativity and exploration through art, music, and play during outings.
