- Accessibility: Store and display resources where all children can independently choose and select them.

Maintenance and Care

- Regular Inspections: Check equipment and resources at the beginning and end of each
- Repair and Replacement: Repair or replace damaged, worn-out, or unsafe equipment.
- Cleaning: Clean equipment and resources regularly.
- **Evaluation:** Regularly evaluate the effectiveness of resources based on children's opinions and interests.

Child Engagement

- Encourage children to respect equipment and resources.
- Teach children to tidy up after play.



• Use designated storage areas with clear labelling or visuals.
